

Discipline report:

Dr. Carl Christopher Nqumayo struck from Register

Former Fort McMurray gynecologist Dr. Carl Christopher Nqumayo can no longer practise medicine in Alberta.

Dr. Nqumayo has not practised since September 2005 when several of his patients complained to the College.

A preliminary investigation by the College revealed patient safety was at risk, and Dr. Nqumayo was temporarily suspended. He was subsequently charged

in criminal court and found guilty of sexual assault. Dr. Nqumayo appealed his criminal conviction to the Alberta Court of Appeal and then the Supreme Court of Canada.

In September 2011, the Supreme Court dismissed Dr. Nqumayo's appeal application. Once all avenues of appeal were exhausted, the College permanently removed Dr. Nqumayo from the Register.

Notice of this disciplinary action against Dr. Nqumayo has been shared with regulatory Colleges across Canada and around the world.

Dr. Nqumayo was also ordered to pay \$38,574.87 to cover the costs of the complaint investigation and hearings held by the Investigating Committee and College Council.
